Recently, we've had some arts and crafts fun with our Silverpoint Court Residential Care Home residents, including card making and arranging fresh flowers for our Home.

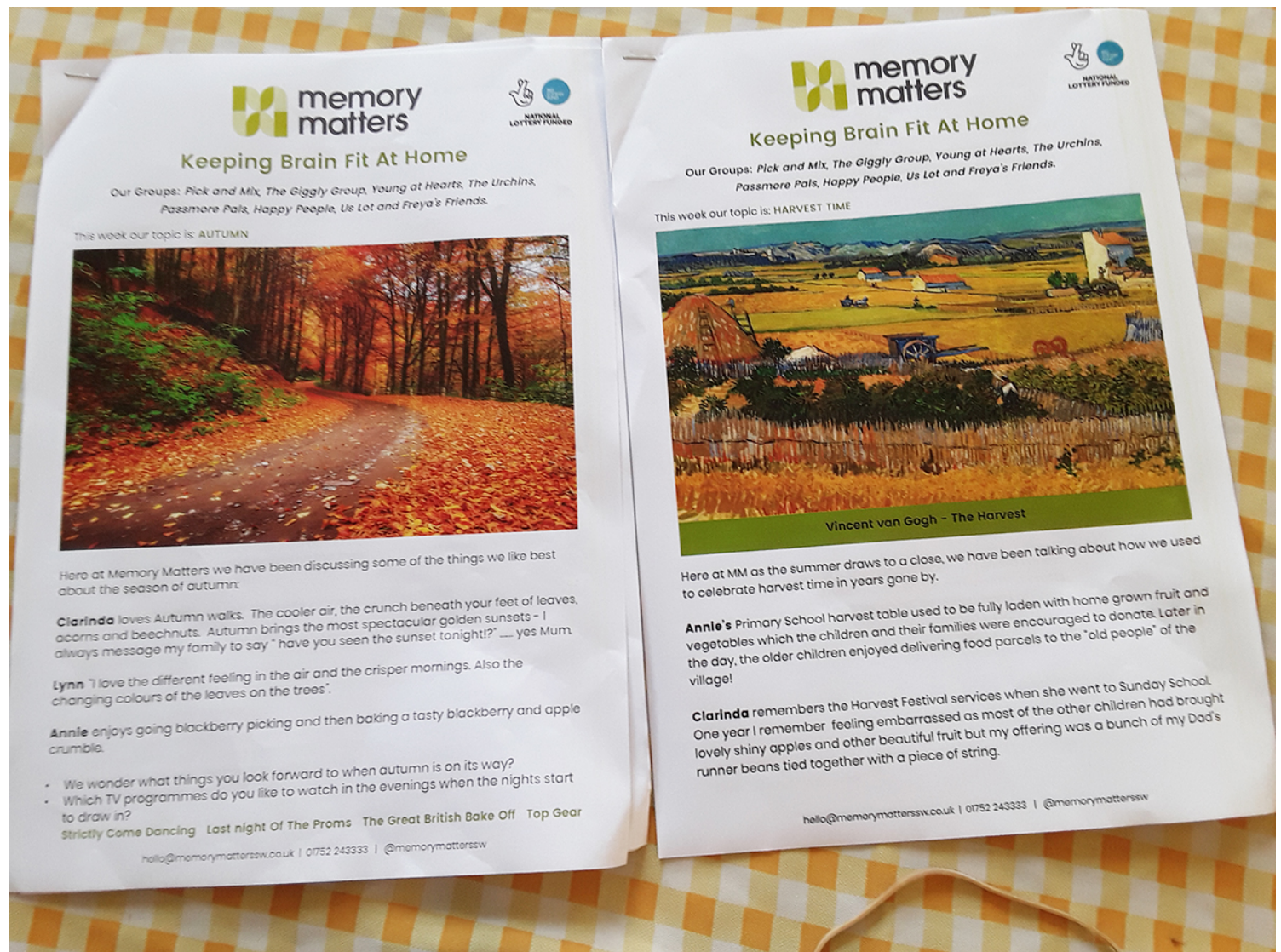
Card game
